P.D.A. (Public or Private Display of Affection)- God has called us to live lives of purity. Anything beyond holding hands with your boy/girl friend between your bodies will result in an adult sitting between the both of you.

People make assumptions by what they see. It is not wise for two people of the opposite sex to be by themselves or with another couple, groups are always safe.

You need to be appropriately clothed. If Frank or another adult feels that what you are wearing is not appropriate, you will be asked to change or to cover yourself up with more clothes. The following is a guideline, but will help, shorts need to have a 3 inch in-seam, no sagging pants or viewed boxers, and your hand placed at the base of the neck needs to cover the top of your shirt.

Bring things that would apply for what we are doing (ie. camping- bring a sleeping bag, Bible Study-bring your Bible, etc.)

No ATWD (alcohol, tobacco, weapons, or drugs). We understand that some people carry pocket knives. However, if it is out without a chaperones knowledge, we could possibly take it up and not return it until later.

Please be responsible for things you bring (i.e. if it is trash, throw it away; clothing, take them with you when you leave; etc.). While on trips, please throw away any trash that you brought onto the van.

Cell Phones- In a fast paced society, cell phones (including text messaging) are extremely useful. However, please be respectful of others, especially during class times or at other times where your undivided attention is requested.
