



Southeast Asia Partnership Overview

Woodburn Baptist's partnership with IMB missionaries in Southeast Asia is to share the gospel to the people of Southeast Asia so that it will lead to a church in each village where we work. Our current work centers around water filter distribution to each home. After the distribution ceremony, teams follow-up in the home to make sure the directions for the water filter are clear and hopefully have an opportunity to guide the conversation to spiritual things. The people of Southeast Asia are very gracious hosts and thankful for our work in bringing clean water. The Southeast Asia Partnership is an investment in the lives of the people who have not heard the Good News of the Gospel. It is also an investment in our IMB missionaries who follow-up long after we are gone. Each water filter provides an open door for them to share as well. The Southeast Asia Partnership is part of Woodburn Baptist Church's 20/20 Vision to start 20 churches by 2020.

Team Member Requirements

All team members are required to make the following commitments in order to go to Southeast Asia on a team from the church. These requirements come from our missionary partners. Volunteers should already demonstrate the following characteristics in their lives.

- 1.) A desire to know God by experiencing His presence, obeying His commands and surrendering your life to His cause.
- 2.) A determination to share the Gospel now.
- 3.) A determination to take Jesus at His word (John 14:12 and 15:5)
- 4.) A willingness to spend lots of time with lost people.
- 5.) A willingness to spend lots of time discipling new believers.
- 6.) Patience and perseverance.
- 7.) A desire to go deep into a new culture for the sake of Kingdom advance.

Frequently Asked Questions

How much does it cost? The cost per person is approximately \$1500.00. Mission trip scholarships are available. You should plan on paying \$500 - \$750.

What paperwork do I need?

You will only need a passport. Visas will be purchased in country.

Are any shots or medications required?

You should check the CDC website for shots required for travel to Southeast Asia and check with your doctor. No shots are required but some are highly recommended.

What should I do to prepare?

You need to be in good physical shape. There is a lot of walking and hiking in the villages. You will need to learn the ANY 3 gospel presentation and be prepared to share it through an interpreter. Be in prayer for opportunities to share and open hearts of village residents.



Going over how to prepare the water filter

Why is the trip so long? (10 days)

The trip is longer than most mission trips because of the great distance traveled. It takes three days to get there. Also the return trip is longer than usual because of the limited hours of operation in some airports. Your time in Southeast Asia is spent traveling to the field, set-up for filter distribution and then three days of follow-up in homes. The trip ends with a meal with translators and national partners before returning home.

Is any training offered?

Once a commitment is made, airline tickets will be purchased in order to get the best rates. Training is offered in learning and practicing the ANY 3 presentation, packing for the trip and a Southeast Asia overview.
